Programs and Services

MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

The goal of our outpatient mental health services is to help people cope with current stressors in order to minimize the impact on their daily lives. SCARF offers a variety of services for individuals, groups and families consisting of assessments, testing, evaluations, and psychiatric services, as well as individual, family and group therapy. SCARF professionals will assist families find the best program after the initial appointment.

SCHOOL-BASED COUNSELING

The purpose of our school based mental health services is to serve those children who may not otherwise be engaged in traditional outpatient services and also to work in conjunction with school personnel and Department of Children and Family Services to assist those youth and families whose mental health issues are having an impact on their functioning and quality of life.

ADOLESCENT SUBSTANCE ABUSE OUTPATIENT PROGRAM

A time limited, multi-faceted treatment for adolescents that include didactic presentations and psycho-educational information, individual counseling, group counseling, family counseling, and regular urine drug screens.

TELEHEALTH

Telehealth allows our health care professionals to evaluate, diagnose and treat patients in remote locations using telecommunications technology. The goal of our telehealth is to allow patients in remote locations to access medical expertise quickly, efficiently and without travel.

CHILDREN AND ADULTS COMMUNITY SUPPORTS

Case management services provide rehabilitative, environmental support and resource coordination considered essential to assist an individual in gaining access to necessary services and in restoring him or herself to the best possible functional level.



PSYCHIATRIC SERVICES
